

TROLLHAUGEN LANGUAGE ARTS AND CULTURE CAMP THEME: Norwegian Mythology DATES: SUNDAY, AUGUST 12 – SATURDAY AUGUST 18, 2018

Trollhaugen Language Arts & Culture Camp is held at Deer Valley Meadows, located near Alix, Alberta. We provide a week-long immersion into Norwegian language, history, crafts, and culture. Our volunteers provide course instruction, programs and camp wide activities.

Registration

All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult that will be actively responsible for them at camp. The adult must sign and submit the Accompanying Adult Consent form. Camp fees include instruction, materials, meals and dormitory accommodation or an RV site. Everyone at camp is expected to help with chores and daily tasks in some capacity. Please come prepared to participate.

Camp Fees

Non-member \$400.00, Adult member \$350.00, Seniors \$145.00*, Ages 5-18 \$300.00, Ages 4 and under \$25.00. A \$25.00 deposit is required for each person applying for camp and must accompany your application. The deposit is included in the fees listed above, and a cheque for the remaining balance may be post dated to May 30, 2018. If you are an instructor/assistant two or more classes, first aide, host or assistant lodge representative your fees will be waived. If you are an instructor or assistant teaching one class your fees are: Non-member \$200.00, Member \$175.00.

New Seniors rate If you are 70 years or older and have collectively attended camp for 15 years or more years then you are eligible for the new fee of \$145.00.

Contact the registrar (contact information below) for information about possible financial assistance in your area for youth campers.

Trollhaugen Society Membership

Membership fee is \$20 per year and may be paid with application if you wish to take advantage of the reduced rate for camp fees.

Application Deadline: May 30, 2018

Early application is advised. Please ensure all forms and fees are in order before sending, or your application could be delayed. Refunds require approval by the Board of Directors. Cheques and money orders should be made payable to Trollhaugen Language Arts and Culture Camp and mailed along with all required forms to the registrar. Notice of confirmation and receipt for fees paid (or notice of no space available) will be issued.

Accommodation

A limited number of dormitory rooms are available. They are shared spaces. Children who have completed grade 4 are assigned rooms (grouped according to grade completed). This allows the children to form life long friendships thus, enhancing the overall camp experience. Exceptions are considered and may be made if a request is made and the person is named on the application form. Children who have not

completed grade four must stay with the accompanying adult. Dormitory-type accommodation or RV sites are available for adults and families. RV sites have power and there is a dump station on site. Please be sure to include RV size on application form.

Arrival at Camp

Registration at camp begins at 4:00pm on Sunday August 12, 2018 and takes place at the dining hall.

Camp Set Up

We need volunteers to help unload the trailer, set up the woodworking shop, and lighting, etc. on Sunday, August 13 before Camp begins. Can you help do this when you bring your children to camp? If so, please contact us at trollhaugencamp@gmail.com.

Departure

<u>Departure date is Saturday, August 19</u> after the program. Make sure your children have all their belongings removed and their rooms clean by 11:00 am for room inspection. If rooms are left in an unacceptable state a **cleanup fee of \$20.00 per person** will be charged.

Culture Activities and Classes

Programs and classes are provided for adults and for children five years of age and older. Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising children under five (please see Camp Rules #14). Children are grouped into classes determined by grade and enrollment. Teens who have completed grade 9 and adults are also grouped by interest.
